FEES

1. Entry Fees apply to Open show exhibitors only. Junior Beef exhibitors receive one (1) vehicle hangtag and are exempt from Entry Fees; however, they are not exempt from Late Fees.

TOTAL PREMIUMS OFFERED

\$95,316 (This figure does not include value of other awards; i.e. ribbons, rosettes, banners, gift cards, scholarships, etc.)

PREMIUM CHECKS

1. Exhibitors awarded over \$599.00 must produce a valid, signed W-9 to be awarded premium (prize) monies.
2. Premiums will be paid within thirty (30) days after the close of the Fair.
3. Premium checks not cashed in ninety (90) days of issue date become void and will not be reissued.
4. Lost or stolen premium checks will not be reissued past sixty (60) days of original issue date.
5. No claim that a premium(s) has not been paid, or that there was a discrepancy in payment of the premium(s) won, will be considered when claim is made later than November 30 following the Fair.
6. Premiums may be withheld if bedding area is left unclean. Junior Beef exhibits are expected to be maintained in a clean and orderly manner. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of premium money.

SCHOLARSHIPS *(Exhibitor must be present to win)*

1. The South Carolina Farm Bureau Federation is proud to offer two (2) \$2,500 beef scholarships annually.
2. SC Farm Livin' is proud to offer one (1) \$500 beef scholarship annually in memory of Jason Dobbins.
3. **NEW IN 2021:** There will be a \$500 beef scholarship given in memory of Marty Hrlc.
4. Winners of the SC Farm Bureau Scholarships are not eligible to compete in subsequent years for the Farm Livin' or Marty Hrlc scholarships.

BREEDS *(Open & Junior Show unless specified otherwise)*

1. Angus, Charolais, Crossbred & AOB, Gelbvieh / Balancer, Hereford, Red Angus, Shorthorn, Simmental, Sim Angus, Zebu-Based Breeds & Crossbreds, Miniature Zebu (OPEN ONLY).
2. An Open Show Supreme Champion Female competition will be held on Friday, Oct. 22 at 2:00 pm. All Grand Champion open breed females to compete.

OPEN AND JUNIOR SIM ANGUS BREED

1. These shows are open to animals that are half-blood Simmental up to less than "purebred" status and registered with the American Simmental Association.
2. Sire and dam of animals must be registered with ASA as Simmentals or as foundation animals.

ZEBU-BASED BREEDS

Those animals entered in the Zebu Based Breeds classification will be sifted by a committee at check-in for predominant zebu characteristics. Those deemed not conforming will be moved to the Crossbreds & All Other Breeds classification.

RULES and REGULATIONS

The South Carolina State Fair General Rules and Regulations shall apply.

CATTLE REGISTRATION PAPERS

Registration papers are required for cattle breeds – Angus, Charolais, Gelbvieh / Balancer, Hereford, Red Angus, Simmental, Sim-Angus, Shorthorn, Miniature Zebu, Jr. Feeder & Market Steers. Papers are to remain with the cattle throughout the fair.

BREED ELIGIBILITY

All animals showing, except Crossbreds, must be registered with their National Breed Association.

DIVISIONS & EXHIBITOR ELIGIBILITY

- Open Division - Open to the World
- Junior Division - Open only to South Carolina 4-H and FFA members

ENTRY REGISTRATION is required during the Open or Late Entry Registrations Periods.

1. ShoWorks Online Entry is the preferred entry method. A confirmation will appear on your screen at the end of a successful registration. It is recommended that the exhibitor print this confirmation.
2. You may also register using a current year Beef Cattle entry form. Deliver completed form via Postal Mail to SC State Fair Entry Office, PO Box 393, Columbia SC 29202. Please include a self-addressed, stamped business size envelope to receive a confirmation from fair when entry form is received.
3. Entry forms must be received by the closing date in the Entry Office during business hours.
4. Entry forms received during later registration must be accompanied by the \$25 Late Fee.
5. Incomplete entry forms will not be processed.

6. The Beef Show Manager may reject any applications that are not properly prepared or that are received or postmarked after the late entry closing date.
7. Cattle not registered in the show will not be allowed on the grounds unless permission is obtained from the Show Manager prior to the Show

LATE ENTRY REGISTRATION

1. Entry forms received during late registration must be accompanied by the \$25 Late Fee.
2. Late fees must be charged to a major credit card (MasterCard or Visa) or money order.
3. **Checks will not be accepted during the Late Entry Registration Period.**
4. Absolutely no entries will be accepted following the close of the registration period.

CONFIRMATION

Following close of the Late Registration Period, a Confirmation Letter, Exhibitor Card, and Vehicle Hangtag(s) will be mailed to all cattle exhibitors. If you have not received the letter and hang tags by Oct 10, contact the Show Secretary at 864.656.9900.

1. The Vehicle Hangtag must be displayed in your vehicle to enter Gate 5.
2. The Confirmation letter and Exhibitor Card must be presented, along with animal health papers, and Registration Certificates upon arrival at the Fairgrounds.
3. The Exhibitor Card should be completed prior to arrival at the fairgrounds and will be taken up at the entrance gate.
4. Beef Cattle exhibitors, cattle or equipment will not be allowed in the barns before 4:00 pm on Tuesday.

VEHICLE HANG-TAGS

1. Vehicle Hangtags must be purchased at time of entry registration.
2. Registered Junior Beef exhibitors will receive one (1) FREE vehicle hangtag; additional vehicle hangtags may be ordered during the online registration process (\$10), if needed.
3. Please anticipate your needs and order accordingly.
4. Vehicle Hangtags will be mailed to exhibitors after close of Late Entry Registration Period.
5. Vehicle Hangtags will not be available for purchase after the Late Entry Registration Period or at the fair.

ARRIVAL TO FAIRGROUNDS

1. All Beef Cattle registered in both the Open and Junior shows will be received in the barns after 4:00 pm on Tuesday and must be checked in no later than 4:00 pm Wednesday. Junior Show only entries will be received on Friday and must be checked in no later than 4:00 pm.
2. Enter at Gate 5 on George Rogers Blvd. with Vehicle Hang-Tag visible through vehicle windshield.
3. Appropriate registration certificate on each animal must be presented to the Cattle Superintendent upon arrival.
4. It is most important that registration papers, together with official health certificates, be available on arrival to the fairgrounds and in the hands of the owner or herdsman in charge of cattle.

PARKING

1. No vehicle will be allowed to park adjacent to any of the cattle barns.
2. Exhibitors will load/unload their supplies and move their trucks to the parking area designated by the Superintendent.

ANIMAL REGISTRATION PAPERS

1. Animal Registration papers are required for all cattle breeds – Angus, Charolais, Gelbvieh / Balancer, Hereford, Red Angus, Simmental, Sim-Angus, Shorthorn and Miniature Zebu. Papers are to remain with the cattle throughout the fair.
2. As entries are received by the Beef Show manager, registrations will be checked on their respective breed association website for ownership and accuracy of information submitted.
3. No animals accepted with PENDING registration.
4. At the discretion of the Management, registration papers may be called for in the Show Ring on all animals showing in Group classes.
5. Junior Beef Entries must be registered in the exhibitor's name.

OWNERSHIP

1. Any exhibitor registering an animal in any name other than the bona fide owner, or owners, or showing an animal in a class for which it is not eligible, may, at the discretion of Management, be barred from further showing, and any or all premiums previously awarded may be forfeited.
2. In all Group Classes, only one (1) entry, per exhibitor, per class is allowed. Bring individual registration papers to show ring at time of judging. All animals per registration form must be same owner.
3. The breeder of an animal is the owner of the cow at the time of service; however, The American Angus Association officially accepts for competition herds purchased in entirety as bred and owned by the current owner.
4. Animals owned in partnership may be registered in proper classes in one (1) owner's name. Entry shall carry a footnote showing the actual ownership of the animal as appearing on the herd book records.

BLOOD TYPING

Blood Typing for Parentage Verification: Refer to the Association Rules.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

1. Cattle must conform to [SC Animal Health Requirements](#).
2. Cattle crossing state lines (out-of-state) for showing require a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI, health certificate) and official individual identification (tattoos and brands are NOT acceptable for interstate movement). Individual identification must be recorded on the CVI. The CVI must be written within thirty (30) days of the show and must accompany the cattle on arrival.
3. Testing is not required for cattle originating from Brucellosis Free and Tuberculosis Free States. Please call Clemson Livestock Poultry Health at 803.788.2260 for additional information.
4. Please indicate by checking box on entry form whether your animals are BST-FREE.

STALLS

Entry fees do not dictate stall space. Exhibitors will receive stalls only for animals delivered to the fair.

CHECK-IN

Registration papers showing ownership in the exhibitors' name must be presented at check-in.

IN THE SHOW RING

1. Bulls must be shown with nose ring or nose lead.
2. Any animal getting loose from the exhibitor twice will be excused from the ring and not placed.
3. Open Show exhibitors are required to wear a show harness and must provide their own.

CARE, FEED, & BEDDING OF CATTLE

1. Owner is responsible for feed, bedding, and care his animals. Cattle are to be watered and fed in stalls or at tie-outs, not on wash rack, in aisles or doorways.
2. Each exhibitor is requested to limit the amount of feed and hay brought into the show barn to one (1) day's supply.
3. A \$10.00 per head, per day charge will be assessed to 4-H, FFA, or adult exhibitors who fail to feed and water their cattle or maintain a clean exhibit.

BEDDING

1. No straw bedding allowed in barns or tie-outs.
2. Initial wood shavings and tie-out bedding free.

CHUTES

No blocking chutes will be allowed in the barns. They may be placed in a designated area adjacent to the barn.

ATTENTION JUNIOR BEEF EXHIBITORS

1. NO FITTING (adhesive, paint, etc.). Clean & dry, blow & brush only.
2. Classes are provided for weaned heifers only, no cow/calf pairs, except for senior yearling females with natural calf at side.
3. The Junior Beef breed shows will start at 8:00 am and proceed according to the schedule.
4. Junior Beef exhibitors are expected to show their own animals.
5. Any animal getting loose from the exhibitor twice will be excused from the ring and will not be placed.
6. Junior Beef exhibitors must show their own animal in the showmanship class, no substitutions allowed.
7. Junior exhibitors may show only one (1) showmanship class even if they have more than one (1) breed.
8. Payment of premiums will be by check to exhibitors or on request to clubs or chapters. Junior Beef exhibits are expected to be maintained in a clean and orderly manner. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of premium money.

VETERINARIAN POLICY

1. Names and telephone numbers of qualified local veterinarians will be posted in the Superintendent's office.
2. Exhibitor is responsible for payment of any veterinary care performed on their animal(s) from an on-site veterinarian.

MISTREATMENT OF ANIMAL

Fair management reserves the right to remove any exhibitor from the grounds who is deemed to be mistreating any animal.

SICK ANIMALS

May be released immediately, if a statement signed by a veterinarian is presented to the Superintendent.

HOT SHOWERS

Available for cattle exhibitors daily from 8:00 am - 10:30 am and 5:00 pm - 10:30 pm.

CONDUCT

Youth will be expected to govern themselves by the 4-H Code of Ethics.

ADDITIONS/CHANGES DEADLINE

No additions or changes made after the books are closed.

SIGNS

The SC State Fair Management reserves the right to refuse permission for any individual exhibitor to erect or display any sign of objectionable size or content.

NO DOGS OR PETS

1. Other than service animals, no dogs or pets shall be permitted on the fairgrounds or in exhibit buildings during the fair except when confined within the campgrounds or unless they are part of an authorized act or exhibit.
2. Pets in the campgrounds must always be leashed.

NOTICES

1. **NO ACOLOHOLIC BEVERAGES:** Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the SC State Fair grounds.
2. **NO SMOKING:** Smoking is not permitted in any building on the fairgrounds, nor in Kiddy Land.
3. **NO FOOD IN LIVESTOCK AREAS:** The consumption and/or distribution of edible products is prohibited in all livestock areas.

RELEASE

- Cattle will be released after the Scholarship Presentations on Saturday.
- Any exhibitor removing animals without official release, not maintaining cattle and space, or failing to remove manure from exhibit to proper area, will forfeit all premiums (prize monies).

RULE INTERPRETATION

Show officials reserve the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations and to settle and determine all matters, questions, or differences in regard thereto or connection with no incident to the show.

HERDSMAN AWARDS (Open & Junior Beef)

Judging Criteria:

A committee appointed by the Cattle Superintendent will make inspections during the week to determine who, always and in their judgement, makes the best record considering the following for a total of 100 points:

- 30 points - Neatness and attractiveness of exhibit, bedding, signs, tack area, etc.
- 30 points - Appearance of cattle.
- 20 points - Cleanliness of aisles in front of and behind cattle.
- 20 points - Exhibitors' behavior towards the public, fellow exhibitors, and fair management. Exhibitors' and the employees' appearance, conduct, etc.

Junior Exhibitors: Please review pages 1-4 of this guide in addition to the following:

VEHICLE HANG-TAGS

1. Registered Junior Beef exhibitors will receive one (1) FREE vehicle hangtag; additional vehicle hangtags may be ordered only during the online registration process (\$7). Please anticipate your needs and order accordingly. Extra Vehicle Hangtags must be purchased at time of entry registration.
2. Vehicle Hangtags will be mailed to exhibitors after close of Late Entry Registration Period.
3. Vehicle Hangtags will not be available for purchase after the Late Entry Registration Period or at the fair.

ATTENTION JUNIOR BEEF EXHIBITORS

1. NO FITTING (adhesive, paint, etc.). Clean and dry, blow and brush only.
2. Classes are provided for weaned heifers only, no cow/calf pairs, except for senior yearling females with natural calf at side.
3. All Junior Steers will be weighed on Friday, October 22 at 4:00 pm and sorted into classes accordingly.
4. The Junior Beef breed shows will start at 8:00 am and proceed according to the schedule.
5. Junior Beef exhibitors are expected to show their own animals.
6. Any animal getting loose from the exhibitor twice will be excused from the ring and will not be placed.
7. Junior Beef exhibitors must show their own animal in the showmanship class, no substitutions allowed.
8. Junior exhibitors may show only one (1) showmanship class even if they have more than one (1) breed.
9. Payment of premiums will be by check to exhibitors or on request to clubs or chapters. Junior Beef exhibits are expected to be maintained in a clean and orderly manner. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of premium money.
