PREMIUM CHECKS

- Exhibitors awarded over \$599.00 must produce a valid, signed W-9 to be awarded premium (prize) monies.
- Premiums will be paid within thirty (30) days after the close of the Fair.
- Premium checks not cashed in ninety (90) days of issue date become void and will not be reissued.
- Lost or stolen premium checks will not be reissued past sixty (60) days of original issue date.
- No claim that a premium(s) has not been paid, or that there
 was a discrepancy in payment of the premium(s) won, will
 be considered when claim is made later than November 30
 following the Fair.

RULES and REGULATIONS

The South Carolina State Fair General Rules and Regulations shall apply.

ENTRY REGISTRATION

- Online entry registration is the preferred method for registering entries. A link to ShoWorks entry system is found on the Competitions page at www.scstatefair.org.
- Online entry registrations are confirmed at time of submission.
- Please print/save and bring your confirmation on Delivery Day.
- An exhibitor may opt to mail an entry form and must include a self-addressed, stamped legal size envelope to receive a return confirmation that the entry form was received.
- The Show Manager may reject any applications that are not properly prepared or that are received or postmarked after September 1.

REGISTRATION NOTES

- IMPORTANT: Anyone showing swine in any class, including Showmanship, is considered an exhibitor, and must be registered under his name to receive premiums and awards, this includes persons showing in Adult Showmanship, Costume, and Junior Market Hog classes.
- All persons showing in any Swine classes must be registered during the Entry Registration Period to receive payment of premiums. Any NON-registered person participating in these classes may receive ribbons and/or rosettes; however, all premiums will be forfeited.
- Junior Show entries in Open Show must be registered in farm or partnership or be a child of the owner.
- Entry Registration is limited to two (2) entries per exhibitor in each class.

HEALTH REGULATIONS

- Swine are to be inspected on the farm of origin by a veterinarian prior to shipment and receive a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI)* valid for 30 days and have Official Identification. Official ID must be recorded on the CVI*. (*Or approved movement documentation.)
- Official Identification for swine: Official ear tags: Imprinted with Official Ear Tag US Shield and nationally unique official animal identification number. Examples - NUES, Official AIN tags, Official RFID tags
- Ear notching if the ear notching has been recorded in a swine registry association's book of record.
- 4. Tattoos on the ear or inner flank if the tattoo has been recorded in a swine registry association's book of record.
- USDA back tags for moving directly to slaughter, not exhibition.

- Group/Lot Identification for moving directly to slaughter, not Exhibition.
- Swine imported into SC that are consigned directly to slaughter are not required to have a CVI.
- 8. Animal Registration papers must be in the name of the individual, FFA Chapter, 4-H Club, or farm.
- Age shown on the certificate must conform strictly with the animal.
- Exhibitors must furnish their own troughs and are responsible for keeping pens clean and in good condition.
- 11. All Health Regulations are subject to change by Clemson University Livestock-Poultry Health Division.

OUT-OF-STATE SWINE: Please provide the following information to your veterinarian as he/she completes your interstate Certificate of Veterinary Inspection to come to the SC State Fair.

- Certificate of Veterinary Inspection CVI (valid for 30 days) with destination listed as SC State Fair, 1200 Rosewood Dr., Columbia, SC 29201. Official Identification must be recorded on the CVI for each animal.
- 2. Official Identification for swine:
 - a. Official ear tags: imprinted with Official Ear tag US Shield and nationally unique official animal identification number.
 - Examples NUES, Official AIN tags, Official RFID tags
 - Ear notching if the ear notching has been recorded in a swine registry association's book of *record.
 - Tattoos on the ear or inner flank if the tattoo has been recorded in a swine registry association's book of *record". The "record" book must be available for review.
- 3. Entry permit required for all out-of-state feeding or breeding swine (issued by the State Veterinarian, call 803-788-2260).
- To obtain a SC entry permit the swine must originate from a Validated Swine Brucellosis-Free herd and Qualified Pseudorabies-Negative herd or tested negative within 30 days *record of testing must be recorded on the CVI).
- No testing required if originating in a commercial swine operation located in a Swine Brucellosis and Pseudorabies Free state. Permit not required for exhibition.

JR MARKET HOG RULES & REGULATIONS

- The South Carolina State Fair Rules and Regulations and Open Swine Show Rules and Regulations shall apply.
- All Jr Market Hog Exhibitors must register during the Open Registration Period. The entries will be placed on file for three (3) years in accordance with the National Animal Identification System (NAIS).
- Jr Market Hog exhibitor must be minimum five (5) years of age.
- Jr Market Hog exhibitors will be classified by the following age divisions:

Junior – Under 14 as of show date Senior - Ages 14-21 as of show date

- 5. Only barrows and gilts will be accepted.
- 6. Pigs must be castrated and healed before the weigh-in day.
- 7. Jr Market Hogs must weigh 200 pounds or more when weighed-in on show day before fair opening to be eligible to show. Remember, pigs lose weight in hauling (3%).
- All Jr Market Hog entries will be weighed starting at 8:00 am on show day and must be in barn by 9:00 am.

- For each age division (Junior and Senior) the Final Exhibitor Placings will be determined by adding the actual placing in each class (Showmanship, Educational Contest, and Record Book) with the lowest sum placing first.
- 10. Plaques will be given for each class.
- 11. Overall Champion: The Overall Champion is awarded a trophy (sponsored by the South Carolina Pork Board). This winner will be determined by adding the actual placing in each of the following classes: On Foot + Showmanship + Record Book + Educational Contest. The lowest number is the Overall Champion. Ties will be broken by: (1) Record Book Placing (2) Showmanship Placing (3) Educational Contest Score.
- 12. Exhibitors must plan for disposition or sale of their market hog(s).
- All Jr Market Hogs must be removed after completion of show.
- NOTICE: Any change from this schedule without the consent of the Superintendent will result in forfeiture of all prizes and premiums
