I can visit animals at the petting zoo.

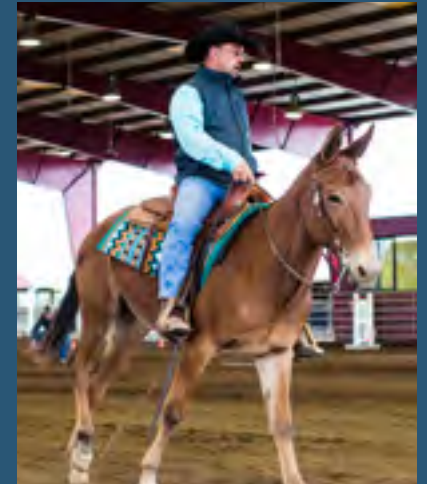


I should always wash my hands after petting and feeding animals.

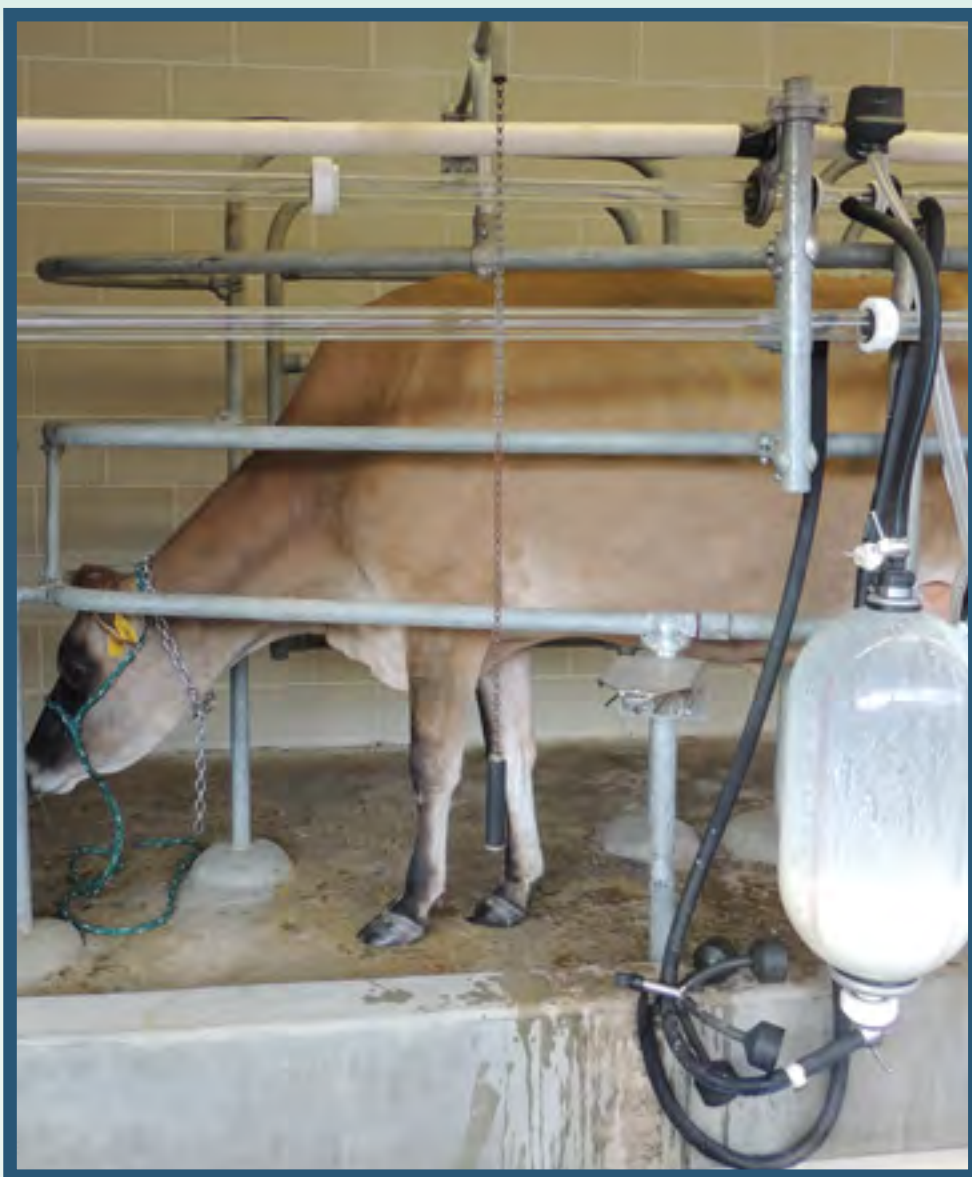

I can walk outside and in the barns to see more animals such as cows, horses, goats and birds.



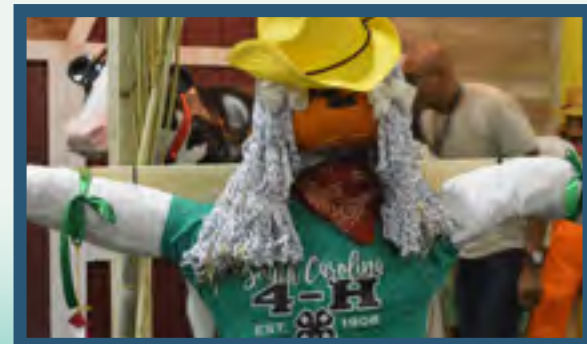
I might even see cows being milked or ducks going down a slide!
