- 1. Registration is limited to the first 50 youth which register. This is a carry-cage event.
- 2. Open to all SC 4-H members in grades K-12. It is not necessary to belong to a 4-H Rabbit club to participate.
- 3. ARBA Showmanship Guidelines will be followed. All rabbits must be free of parasites, or any contagious condition. A health check will be conducted before any rabbit can be kept on the premises.
- 4. You are responsible for providing food and water for your rabbit. Please bring suitable containers form which to feed and water your rabbit.
- 5. Upon arrival, each exhibitor will receive a pick-up tag which will match your rabbit's ID. A rabbit will only be allowed to leave the fairgrounds with the person who has the matching ticket.
- 6. At the conclusion of the show, you will be able to leave your rabbit in a designated safe place, which will always have an employee of the fair watching over the tent and rabbits. This will allow you time to spend at the fairgrounds.
- 7. All rabbits must be picked up by 6:00 pm that night if you choose to remain at the fair.
