All containers and accessories must be claimed on this date.

The SC State Fair and the Show Committee will not be responsible for items left after this time.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The **South Carolina State Fair General Rules and Regulations** shall apply in conjunction with **The South Carolina State Fair Flower Show General Rules and Regulations**.
2. The **Arrangement/Designs Division** is open to any amateur arranger. *You do not have to be a Rose Society member except for classes #1 & # 2. The Arrangement/Designs Division is NOT open to professional florists or anyone who arranges flowers for a living.*
3. **All arrangements are by advance entry only and may be limited to four (4) per class due to space.**
4. **Roses of high quality** should be used in all arrangements, but need not have been grown by the exhibitor. **All roses must be named {ARS Am. Exhibition Name} on the entry tag.** "AG" should be written or checked in the box at the card top for arrangements featuring Arranger-Grown roses. *All roses must be outdoor garden grown. Classes 3-15 with "AG" are eligible for medal certificates.*
5. **ROSES** must be the **DOMINANT FLOWERS** in all arrangements. The rose bloom may not be abstracted. *Roses used in Classes 9-14 must be ones classified as miniature or miniflora.*
6. Other plant material may be used in classes where permitted. *The use of artificial plant material treated or painted fresh plant material, and the use of live creatures are not permitted. The **American Flag** is not permitted in any form.*
7. **Niches will be provided and must be used. Niche sizes:** Classes 1-8 are 36"H x 24"W x 18"D". Classes 9-14 are 10"H x 10"W x 10"D. The mini niches sides will be triangular. Class 15 (Duke) are 22"H x 24"W x 24"D
Backgrounds and underlays are to be used in all classes and must be furnished by the exhibitor. Accessories are permitted in all classes, except Class 15.
8. Decisions of the Judges will be final. Judging will be in accordance with the **American Rose Society Guidelines for Judging Rose Arrangements**. **Only authorized personnel will be allowed in the area during judging.**

9. Entry cards will be furnished by show committee, but must be completed by the exhibitor. *Type of arrangement and rose varieties {ARS Am. Exhibition Name} must be written on each entry card.*

10. Arrangements must be picked up (claimed) on Sunday, October 13, 2024, between 5:00 PM and 6:00 PM. All containers should be marked with exhibitor's name. *No arrangements may be removed from the show area prior to pick up time.*

SC ROSE SOCIETY DESIGN SCHEDULE

- A. ARS National District Rotating Arrangement Trophy – Betty Pavey Award - Must be ARS member - must be arranger grown roses with “AG” – Standard size arrangement with only a first place awarded that must score 92 points or more – modern type with abstract qualities.**

Class 1. ORANGEBURG COUNTY – Festival of Roses – Abstract Design

- B. The Lee Jeremias Memorial Award – A Standard Modern Design – *Eligible for SC Rose Society Lee Jeremias Memorial Award.*** Designer's choice of modern type to be written at the top of the entry tag. *Open only to members of the SC Rose Society.*

Class 2 – Horry County – “Myrtle Beach”

- C. Royalty Award – A Standard Traditional Design - *Eligible for ARS Design Awards and Certificates.*** Designer's choice of type to be written at the top of the entry tag. Fresh roses with fresh and/or dried plant material; fresh fruit and/or vegetables allowed.

Class 3 – Edgefield County – “Peaches” Mass or Line-Mass Design

Class 4 – Greenwood County – “Railroad Historical Center” Line or Line-Mass Design

- D. Artist Award - A Standard Modern Design - *Eligible for ARS Design Awards and Certificates.*** Designer's choice of type to be written at the top of the entry tag. Fresh roses with designer's choice of any other plant materials and components except as previously noted.

Class 5 – Charleston County – “Ravenal Bridge”

Class 6 – Aiken County - “The Bomb Plant”

- E. East Asian Award - Standard East Asian Design - *Eligible for ARS Design Awards and Certificates.*** Designer's choice of type to be written at the top of the entry tag. Fresh roses with designer's choice of any other plant materials and components except as previously noted or prohibited by the design type.

Class 7 – Lexington County – “Lake Murray” – traditional – low container – no free style

Class 8. Newberry County – “Wells Japanese Garden” – (Jiyuka)

F. Mini Royalty Award - Miniature Traditional Design - *Eligible for ARS Design Awards and Certificates.*

Designer's choice of type to be written at the top of the entry tag.

Class 9. PICKENS COUNTY - "Clemson University" - Mass or Line-Mass Design

Class 10. GREENVILLE COUNTY - "Peace Center" – Line or Line-Mass Design

G. Mini Artist Award - Miniature Modern Design - *Eligible for ARS Design Awards and Certificates.* Designer's choice of type to be written at the top of the entry tag.

Class 11. SPARTANBURG COUNTY – "BMW"

Class 12. DARLINGTON COUNTY – "The Race Way"

H. Mini East Asian Award – Miniature East Asian Design – *Eligible for ARS Design Awards and Certificates.*

Designer's choice of type to be written at the top of the entry tag.

Class 13. GEORGETOWN COUNTY – "Huntington Garden" – any East Asian Style except Jiyuka

Class 14. RICHLAND COUNTY – "Riverbanks Zoo" – East Asian Free Style (Jiyuka)

I. Duke Award. *Eligible for ARS Design Awards and Certificates.* Designer's choice of type to be written at the top of the entry tag. Arrangements must be larger than 10 inches in height, width, and depth, but no greater than 20 inches in any direction.
