SHOW INFORMATION

ENTRY FEE: \$20 per class (Open & Junior Exhibitors)

VEHICLE HANGTAG: One (1) complimentary Gate 4 vehicle hang tag will be mailed to each exhibitor in late September.

- Beef Cattle exhibitors requiring additional Gate 4 hang tags for delivering animals or tack may purchase at time of entry registration.
- Vehicles will not be allowed to park adjacent to any cattle barn.
- Exhibitors will load/unload supplies and move vehicles to the parking area designated by the Superintendent.

TOTAL PREMIUMS OFFERED

\$95,316 *(This figure does not include value of other awards, i.e., ribbons, rosettes, banners, belt buckles, gift cards, scholarships, etc.)*

PREMIUM CHECKS

- Exhibitors awarded over \$599.00 must produce a valid, signed W-9 to be awarded premium (prize) monies.
- Premiums will be paid within thirty (30) days after the close of the Fair.
- Premium checks not cashed in ninety (90) days of issue date become void and will not be reissued.
- Lost or stolen premium checks will not be reissued past sixty (60) days of original issue date.
- No claim that a premium(s) has not been paid, or that there was a discrepancy in payment of the premium(s) won, will be considered when claim is made later than November 30 following the Fair.
- Premiums may be withheld if the bedding area is left unclean. Open and Junior Beef exhibits are expected to be maintained in a clean and orderly manner. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of premium money.

*OPEN AND JUNIOR SIM SOLUTIONS BREED

These shows are open to animals that are half-blood Simmental up to less than "purebred" status and registered with the American Simmental Association.

**ZEBU-BASED BREEDS

Those animals entered in the Zebu Based Breeds classification will be sifted by a committee at check-in for predominant zebu characteristics. Those deemed not conforming will be moved to either the Crossbreds or All Other Breeds classification.

***COMMERCIAL HEIFERS:

1. All Commercial Heifers must be weighed in during designated check in times of: October 21 by 4:00 PM and Junior animals need to be weighed by October 23 by 4:00 PM
2. Commercial heifers must weigh a minimum weight of 450 lbs.
3. If a heifer in the Commercial Show does not meet the minimum weight, and the exhibitor only entered in the Commercial Show, management will allow the exhibitor to show in showmanship.
4. An exhibitor may request a re-weigh once a weight has been declared. The request must be announced immediately after coming off the scale. Once the weigh master has zeroed out the scale, the animal may be reloaded. The animal may not leave the check/weigh area. This process may occur once.
5. Commercial Heifer entries will be divided into classes by their weight recorded at check in, weight ranges will not exceed 150 lbs.
6. The Overall Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Commercial Heifer will be eligible to compete in the Top Five Breeding Heifer Drive.

RULES & REGULATIONS

The South Carolina State Fair General Rules and Regulations shall apply. As an exhibitor in the SC State Fair, you agree to the following:

- I have reviewed and agree to abide by the rules and regulations set forth in the online 2026 SC STATE FAIR EXHIBITS GUIDE.

- Upon delivery of my entry, I acknowledge that others will be using said facilities and premises at the same time and that the State Agricultural & Mechanical Society of South Carolina, aka The South Carolina State Fair, is not responsible for the acts, property, equipment and animals of others or the acts or products of any concessionaire.
- I agree that photos of exhibits taken by official fair representatives may be used on the South Carolina State Fair website and social media outlets, such as Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Pinterest, etc.
- I acknowledge that the State Agricultural & Mechanical Society of South Carolina, aka The South Carolina State Fair, is not responsible for any loss, injury, illness, or damage to any animals or property or exhibit articles and that such understanding and agreement is a condition of my entry or exhibit.
- Further, I agree to and hereby indemnify the State Agriculture & Mechanical Society, aka The South Carolina State Fair, from any loss, injury, damage or claim of any third person caused by any animal, exhibit, entry or property of mine or any act of anyone or mine acting on my behalf.

EXHIBITOR ELIGIBILITY

Open Shows – Open to the World.

Junior Shows – Open to Youth 4-H, FFA, and Breed Association members.

The showmanship division is based on age as of January 1st of the current year.

(Scholarship Programs are for SC Youth ONLY.)

ONLINE ENTRY REGISTRATION

- Online entry registration is the preferred method for registering entries. A link to the ShoWorks entry system is found on the SC State Fair website at www.scstatefair.org/competitions
- Online entry registrations are confirmed by email at time of submission.
- Please print/save and bring your confirmation on Delivery Day.
- An exhibitor may opt to mail an entry form and must include a self-addressed, stamped legal size envelope to receive a return confirmation that the entry form was received.
- The Beef Show Manager will reject any applications that are not properly prepared or not received in office by September 1.
- Cattle not registered in the show will not be allowed on the grounds unless permission is obtained from the Show Manager prior to show.

CONFIRMATION

A Confirmation Letter and Vehicle Hangtag(s) will be mailed to all cattle exhibitors. If you have not received the letter and hang tags by Oct 4th, contact the Show Secretary at 864.710.0949.

ARRIVAL TO FAIRGROUNDS – *Enter Gate 4 on George Rogers Blvd.*

- All Beef Cattle registered in both the Open and Junior shows will be received in the barns after 10:00am on Tuesday and must be checked in no later than 4:00 pm Wednesday. Junior Show only entries will be received on Friday and must be checked in no later than 4:00 pm.
- Enter Gate 4 on George Rogers Blvd. with Vehicle Hangtag visible through vehicle windshield where it should remain while inside the fairgrounds.
- Appropriate registration certificate on each animal must be presented to the Cattle Superintendent upon arrival.

- It is most important that registration papers, together with official health certificates, be available on arrival to the fairgrounds and in the hands of the owner or herdsman in charge of cattle.

PARKING

No vehicle will be allowed to park adjacent to any of the cattle barns.

Exhibitors will load/unload their supplies and move their trucks to the parking area designated by the Superintendent.

ANIMAL REGISTRATION PAPERS

- Registration papers must show ownership in the name of the exhibitor.
- Animal Registration papers are required for all cattle breeds. Papers are to remain with the cattle throughout the fair.
- As entries are received by the Beef Show manager, registrations will be checked on their respective breed association website for ownership and accuracy of information submitted.
- No animals accepted with PENDING registration.
- At the discretion of the Management, registration papers may be called for in the Show Ring on all animals showing in Group classes.

OWNERSHIP

- Registration papers must show ownership in the name of the exhibitor.
- Any exhibitor registering an animal by any name other than the bona fide owner, or owners, or showing an animal in a class for which it is not eligible, may, at the discretion of Management, be barred from further showing, and any or all premiums previously awarded may be forfeited.
- In all Group Classes, only one (1) entry, per exhibitor, per class is allowed. Bring individual registration papers to show ring at time of judging. All animals per registration form must be the same owner.
- The breeder of an animal is the owner of the cow at the time of service; however, The American Angus Association officially accepts for competition herds purchased in entirety as bred and owned by the current owner.
- Animals owned in partnership may be registered in proper classes in one (1) owner's name. Entry shall carry a footnote showing the actual ownership of the animal as appearing on the herd book records.

BLOOD TYPING

Blood Typing for Parentage Verification: Refer to the Association Rules.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

- Cattle must conform to [SC Animal Health Requirements](#).
- Cattle crossing state lines (out-of-state) for showing require a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI, health certificate) and official individual identification (tattoos and brands are NOT acceptable for interstate movement). Individual identification must be recorded on the CVI. The CVI must be written within thirty (30) days of the show and must accompany the cattle on arrival.
- Testing is not required for cattle originating from Brucellosis Free and Tuberculosis Free States. Please call Clemson Livestock Poultry Health at 803.788.2260 for additional information.

STALLS

Entry fees do not dictate stall space. Exhibitors will receive stalls only for animals delivered to the fair.

CHECK-IN

Registration papers showing ownership in the exhibitors' name must be presented at check-in.

IN THE SHOW RING

- Bulls must be shown with a nose ring or a nose lead.
- Any animal getting loose from the exhibitor twice will be excused from the ring and not placed.
- Open Show exhibitors are required to wear show harness and must provide their own.

CARE, FEED, & BEDDING OF CATTLE

- Initial wood shavings and tie-out bedding provided free. No straw bedding is allowed in barns or tie-outs.
- The owner is responsible for the feed, additional bedding, and care of his animals. Cattle are to be watered and fed in stalls or at tie-outs, not on wash rack, in aisles or doorways.
- Each exhibitor is requested to limit the amount of feed and hay brought into the show barn to one (1) day's supply.
- A \$10.00 per head, per day charge will be assessed to 4-H, FFA, or adult exhibitors who fail to feed and water their cattle or maintain a clean exhibit.

CHUTES

No blocking chutes will be allowed in the barns. They may be placed in a designated area adjacent to the barn.

JUNIOR BEEF EXHIBITORS

- Registration papers must show ownership in the name of the exhibitor.
- Classes are provided for weaned heifers only, no cow/calf pairs, except for senior yearling females with natural calf at side.
- The Junior Beef showmanship shows will start at 8:00 am with breed shows following. See schedule for approximate times.
- Junior Beef exhibitors are expected to show their own animals. If a youth exhibitor needs assistance in their breed class, they may be assisted by another youth exhibitor who is entered in the show. Junior Beef exhibitors are not allowed assistance in showmanship.
- Any animal getting loose from the exhibitor twice will be excused from the ring and will not be placed.
- Junior Beef exhibitors must show their own animal in the showmanship class, no substitutions allowed.
- Payment of premiums will be by check to exhibitors or on request to clubs or chapters. Junior Beef exhibits are expected to be maintained in a clean and orderly manner. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of premium money.

VETERINARIAN POLICY

- Names and telephone numbers of qualified local veterinarians will be posted in the Superintendent's office.
- Exhibitor is responsible for payment of any veterinary care performed on their animal(s) from an on-site veterinarian.

MISTREATMENT OF ANIMALS

Fair management reserves the right to remove any exhibitor from the grounds who is deemed to be mistreating any animal.

SICK ANIMALS

May be released immediately, if a statement signed by a veterinarian is presented to the Superintendent.

HOT SHOWERS

Available for cattle exhibitors daily from 8:00 am - 10:30 am and 5:00 pm - 10:30 pm.

CONDUCT

Youth will be expected to govern themselves by the [4-H Code of Conduct](#).

ADDITIONS/CHANGES DEADLINE

No additions or changes made after the books are closed.

SIGNS

The SC State Fair Management reserves right to refuse permission for any individual exhibitor to erect or display any sign of objectionable size or content.

NO DOGS OR PETS

Other than service animals, no dogs or pets shall be permitted on the fairgrounds or in exhibit buildings during the fair except when confined within the campgrounds or unless they are part of an authorized act or exhibit. Pets in the campgrounds must always be leashed.

NOTICES

- **NO ACOLOHOLIC BEVERAGES:** Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the SC State Fair grounds.
- **NO SMOKING:** Smoking is not permitted in any building on the fairgrounds, nor in Kiddy Land.
- **NO FOOD IN LIVESTOCK AREAS:** The consumption and/or distribution of edible products is prohibited in all livestock areas.

RELEASE

Cattle will be released after the Scholarship Presentations on Saturday. Any exhibitor removing animals without official release, not maintaining cattle and space, or failing to remove manure from exhibit to proper area, will forfeit all premiums (prize monies).

RULE INTERPRETATION

Show officials reserve the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations and to settle and determine all matters, questions, or differences in regard thereto or connection with no incident to the show.

AWARDS

SC STATE FAIR PRESIDENT'S CHOICE AWARD

Open Beef – Silver Belt Buckle + \$300

Junior Beef – Silver Belt Buckle + \$450

Purpose:

The President's Award was designed to bestow the highest recognition to an outstanding exhibitor of the South Carolina State Fair who has demonstrated exceptional involvement in the livestock industry and is an advocate for agriculture and livestock education. The president's Choice Award is considered the highest honor at the South Carolina State Fair.

Selection:

President Award Recipients will be selected in the following species: Jr Beef, Open Beef, Jr Dairy, Open Dairy, Dairy Goat, Jr Market Goat, Jr Sheep, Smallstock, Jr Swine, Open Swine, and Youth Horse.

Guidelines:

- The South Carolina State Fair President's Competition is open to all 2026 South Carolina State Fair youth and open exhibitors (exhibitor is defined as an individual that exhibits an animal show in a minimum of one class in one specie show and receives an official placing by the judge.) Contestants may only compete in one specie area in which they are currently exhibiting.
- Once a youth exhibitor is recognized with the President's Award, they will not be eligible to compete for this award in the same species again. Youth winners are eligible to compete in the open division in future years.
- Once an open exhibitor is recognized with the President's Award, they will not be eligible for that award in future years.

Selection Information:

This distinguished award will be selected by the specie superintendent and the specie support staff.

The intent of this prestigious award is determined by the following criteria:

- Exhibits will be evaluated each day of the designated specie show by the specie superintendent and the South Carolina State Fair Show Staff. There will be separate awards for:
- Cleanliness of the exhibit area from the conclusion of species check in through the conclusion of the specie show.
- The aisles must be kept clean. Feed and water pails should be neat, clean, and removed from the stalls/pens when not in use.
- Identification such as stall cards and farm signs are highly encouraged.
- Manure must be removed from stalls/pens and placed in appropriate containers/areas.
- The appearance of animals should be clean and always cared for.
- Livestock should be in the barn/stall area when not being groomed or shown.
- Courtesy to other exhibitors, spectators and show officials will count towards the award. Disregard for show and facility rules and regulations will count against award calculations.
- Positive interaction with the public during the designated specie competition time frame.

SUPREME CHAMPION FEMALE AWARD – OPEN SHOW

Registered Junior Beef exhibitors will receive one (1) complimentary Gate 4 vehicle hangtag. Vehicle Hangtags will be mailed to exhibitors in late September.

ATTENTION JUNIOR BEEF EXHIBITORS

- Classes are provided for weaned heifers only, no cow/calf pairs, except for senior yearling females with natural calf at side.
- All Junior Steers will be weighed on Friday, October 17 at 4:00 pm and sorted into classes accordingly.
- The Junior Beef Showmanship contest will start at 8:00 am , with breed shows to follow and proceed according to the schedule.
- Junior Beef exhibitors are expected to show their own animals.
- Any animal getting loose from the exhibitor twice will be excused from the ring and will not be placed.
- Junior Beef exhibitors must show their own animal in the showmanship class, no substitutions allowed.
- Payment of premiums will be by check to exhibitors or on request to clubs or chapters. Junior Beef exhibits are expected to be maintained in a clean and orderly manner. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of premium money.
